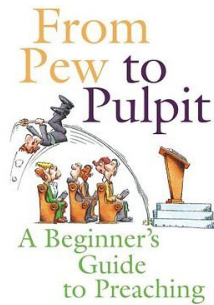

### Called to Speak

The Preuningers return to the Finger Lakes Lay Servant Retreat to lead honing public speaking skills, specifically preaching a prepared sermons or messages.

Anyone who has stepped in front of a congregation to deliver a sermon, read scripture, or lead a liturgy knows that it takes more than inspiration and passion to effectively communicate the gospel. It takes intentional work to develop and maintain the physiological and mechanical skills your calling requires.

During the course, we discuss the issues raised in Clifton F. Guthrie's *From Pew to Pulpit* on sermon preparation and delivery, and workshop portions of your sermon. You are asked to bring two copies of a sermon or message that you have preached. In group settings, we work with specific emphasis on delivery and how to use the vocal and bodily tools you already possess in engaging the listener.

If time allows, we transfer these skills to other acts of worship, including scripture reading and the leading of prepared liturgy.
