Through a variety of activities, ideas, and informational handouts, “The Worship Workshop” helps worship committees, planners, and designers evaluate the state of their current worship, get more people involved in the planning and designing process, explore the diverse designs of congregational worship, learn the history of worship, and utilize the arts and artists in worship.

“Equipping Yourself for Spiritual Care Visitation”

Instructor: Rev. Dr. Richard McCaughey was a United Methodist local church pastor for twenty-five years, and then Director of Spiritual Care for Thompson Health for fourteen years. He has served as pastor, in the summers, at Big Moose Community Chapel, in the Adirondacks, for twenty years.

While at Thompson Health, he developed a visitation program which received NYS recognition as an outstanding volunteer program. He will provide training and dialogue regarding the art of spiritual care visitation. In addition, Rev. McCaughey will engage participants in conversation regarding growth of their own spirituality.

“Basic Lay Servant Course”

The Basic Lay Servant Course is an overview study and exploration into the many ways Christians may serve our Lord through Lay Servant Ministries. It is the foundation course for Lay Servant Ministries.

Participants are invited to consider the importance of exercising servant leadership, developing future leaders, remaining rooted in consistent spiritual practices, and being part of a group that holds members accountable in discipleship. It offers guidelines for best practices as a church leader and outlines a number of ministries in which Lay Servants may assume roles.

Whether one decides to proceed in the process to become a Lay Servant or not, this course is excellent for all church laity in leadership positions. Who Should Take The Advanced Courses?

Primarily aimed at Lay Servants, these classes are open to anyone (clergy or laity). Lay Servants may use these courses to fulfill the requirement of at least one advanced /refresher course, each three years, to maintain status.
