The location of this year's banquet is, once again, Samuel's Grande Manor, 8750 Main Street, Williamsville, NY. (Main Street is also Rt. 5)

Dinner reservation process is online again this year! Reservations can be made by following this link. (The full web address is at the end of this letter.) This allows you to pay through PayPal (you can use a debit or credit card, but it has to go thru PayPal). If you choose to pay by check, payment must be received in the District Office by May 10.

The price of the event this year is \$30 per person. Each church is responsible for the cost of their honoree's dinner. One person may register for a group; you will be asked to give the names of those you are registering.

Enclosed is the Honoree form and all the information you will need to help make this the great success it has been in previous years. <u>Please take note of the deadline dates for submitting your forms, and where to return them.</u>

Our Master of Ceremonies, Rev. Carlos Rosa-Laguer, along with Banquet Chairperson, Linda Barczykowski, will guide us through an evening of fellowship, great food, music, and worship. As in past years, the highlight of the evening will be the recognition of the individual church honoree(s). - Honoree Form: In order to be sensitive to all honorees, biographies must be limited to 50 words or less. They will be read as the person or group is being recognized that night. The deadline for all honoree biography forms is May 1.
- 2. The Reservation Link: Paid reservations are essential in order to have a successful banquet. Final deadline for all paid reservations is May 7 and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. A final count must be given to Samuel's by May 10.
