#### (5) NEW! Clergy: Register now for required Boundary Awareness Training

In our life together, clergy are called to maintain boundaries as a means of maintaining covenant with each other and with those whom they serve. Understanding these boundaries and strategies to maintain them is important to doing ministry together.

Beginning in September, the Upper New York Conference Board of Ordained Ministry is offering Boundary Awareness Training for all clergy under appointment – this is not the same as Safe Sanctuary Training. This training is mandatory for all pastors in the Upper New York Conference.

The trainings will be led by the Rev. Diane Wheatley, in partnership with the Capital Region Theological Center. Rev. Wheatley is an ordained clergy member of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America. Sessions will be held on the following dates and locations:

Sept. 24 at the Casowasco Camp & Retreat Center, Moravia

Sept. 25 at the Shenendehowa United Methodist Church, Clifton Park

Sept. 26 at the Plattsburgh UMC

You are welcome to register for any event, pending space availability. You need only attend one event. You may register online for any event through the Capital Region Theological Center at <a href="mailto:crtc.org/upcoming/eventgroup">crtc.org/upcoming/eventgroup</a>.

The total fee for the course is \$85, which will be due upon check-in at the training. You may request a mini-grant (\$30) from your available continuing education

funds from the Board of Ordained Ministry during the registration process or by contacting the Rev. Wayne Mort at <a href="wayneamort@aol.com">wayneamort@aol.com</a>. You will receive notification regarding the awarding of these funds prior to the event, however, you should come to the course prepared to pay.
