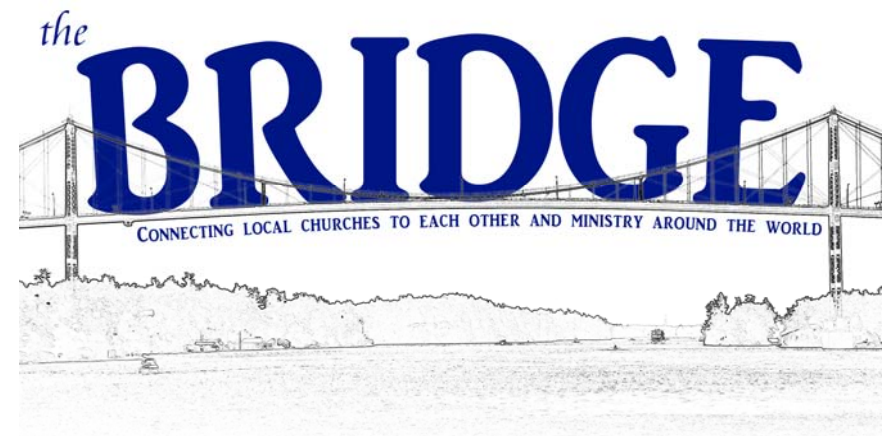
have put forth in managing our spending."
